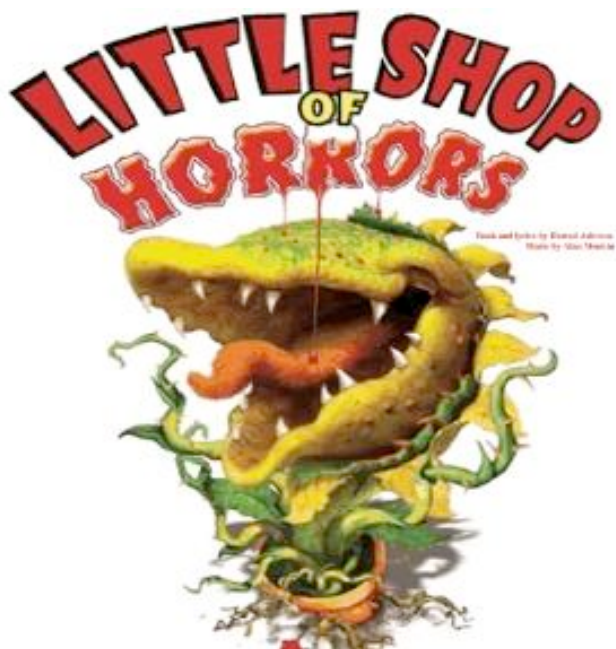


Baltimore Theatre Project
